



Easy Folds for Fun Wraps

1 POSTER = 4 BAGS

1 Cut along the poster folds to make four 7-by-10½-inch paper sheets.

Brio's wrapping-paper posters are back! So, ask yourself: *Should I hang them on the wall? Do I use them to wrap presents? Or can I make them into unique boxes and gift bags?* The answer to all three is yes!

Whether you're giving baked goods, clothing, artwork or something you're keeping

a secret, you can use your wrapping-paper posters to make adorable boxes, bags and more.

'Tis the season to give holiday cheer, along with thoughtful presents. So dive into the festivities and unleash your creativity this Christmas season with our *Brio* wrapping-paper posters!

2 Make a 1-inch fold along the top long edge.

3 Fold the left side to the right 4 inches.

4 Overlap the right edge ½ inch over the folded left side and adhere.

5 Fold the bottom up 1½ inch toward the top.

6 Open the bottom fold and press the left and right sides flat, toward the center.

7 Fold the top flap just over the center crease.

8 Fold the bottom flap just over the top flap and attach together.

9 Fold each side ¼ inch inward.

10 Open the bag and press bottom flat.

11 Press side center folds inward.

12 Add a gift, tissue paper, a string handle and a gift tag for your special someone.

Bag size: 3½-by-5¼ inches

1 POSTER = 2 BOXES WITH LIDS



1 Cut along the poster folds to make two 7-by-10½-inch paper sheets. Then trim to make two 7-by-7-inch sheets, and two 5-by-5-inch sheets.



2 Fold the 7-by-7 sheet in half, then open it. Fold the long edges in, meeting the middle fold line. Open.



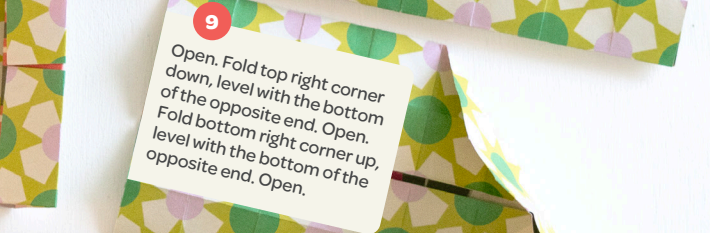
3 Fold in half, opening edges facing outward.



4 Open. Fold right side to meet the middle fold line.



5 Fold left side to meet the middle fold line.



6 Open. Then fold long edges in toward the middle fold line (opening edges facing outward).



Open the right side then fold it to meet the far left edge. Then bring the fold back to look like step 5. Repeat on the left side. Open.

Fold the right side to meet the nearest fold line on the right. Repeat on the left side. You should have seven vertically folded lines. Flip over.

Crease long edges up. Fold in short edges and squish to make the end side.



12 Repeat step 9 for the left side.

Push down center fold line in end to shape end side.



13 Repeat steps 11 and 12 for other end side.



Shape to round out ends.

Using the 5-by-5-inch paper, fold the square equally into fourths by folding the bottom to the top and the left to the right. Open.

Fold each corner to the center.

Fold right side to center



4
Fold left side to center. Open.



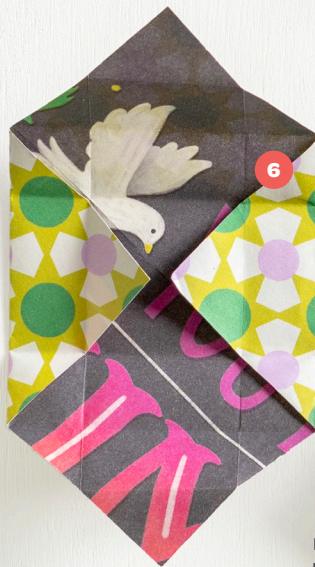
Fold top and bottom sides to the center. Open.

7
Fold the left and right sides on the new crease to stand up vertically. Then push the corners to form another side.



8
Wrap the top flap over this new side and press down its edges to secure. Adhere, if necessary.

Pull top and bottom folds out from the center.

9
Repeat for the remaining side.



10
Insert lid into candy box. Add a bow and you're done!

Inner box size: 1 3/4-by-1 3/4 inches

1 POSTER = 4 BAGS

1 Cut the poster to make four 7-by-7-inch paper sheets.



Fold the square equally in fourths by folding the bottom to the top and the left to the right. Open.



3 Fold one corner to other corner. Open. Repeat on other side. Open.

4 Take the middle fold and fold it in toward the middle.



5 Do the same to the opposite side.



6 Take the corner on top and fold it up to the middle of the opposite side.



7 Take that same corner and fold it back. Not unfolding the previous step.



8 Repeat steps 5 and 6 to the opposite side. Flip over.



9 Do steps 5-6 on the remaining two corners.



10 Fold the bottom point up toward the middle of the bag.



11 Fold the edge of the corners on top over into the bag.



12 Fold the rest of the corners into the bag. Unfold the bottom of the bag.



13 Open the bag and press the bottom to be flat.



Bag size: 2-by-2 1/2 inches

14 Punch a hole in the top of the bag and a string tie for the finishing touches.



1 POSTER = 2 BOXES AND 4 MINI-BOXES

1 Cut along the poster folds to make four 7-by-10½-inch paper sheets. Then trim to make four 7-by-7-inch sheets.

2 Fold the square equally in fourths by folding the bottom to the top and the left to the right. Open.

Use the paper scraps to make mini-boxes by cutting eight 3-by-3-inch squares.

3 Fold each corner to the center.

4 Fold left and right sides to the center. Open.

5 Fold top and bottom sides to the center. Open.

6 Pull top and bottom folds out from the center.

FOR THE LID: Repeat all steps except for steps 4 and 5. Instead of folding to the center, fold ⅓ inch from the center.

8 Unfold the left and right sides until they are vertical. Push in their top corners to form another side.
9 Wrap the top flap over this new side and press down its edges to secure.

7 Fold the left and right sides on the new crease.

10 Repeat for the remaining side.

Box size:
2-by-2 inches

Mini-box size:
1-by-1 inches
