Sami's vision has transformed Eagles Publishing into a beacon of hope for families in war-torn Ukraine, remote areas of Mongolia, and beyond.

One of the most impactful projects has been distributing "The Right Choices Bible", a resource tailored to introduce children to God's Word through captivating illustrations and bilingual content.

Many churches lack sufficient children's Bibles, hindering their ability to minister effectively to the next generation. Thanks to Sami's passionate efforts, **over 3,000 children's Bibles have been distributed** to churches, Christian organizations, and

families, giving children the opportunity to encounter Jesus and grow spiritually.



Focus on the Family Mongolia, under the leadership of Dr. Hongoroo, has played a vital role in distributing these Bibles and providing holistic support to local families. A passionate advocate for children, Hongoroo leverages her PH.D in Clinical Counseling to

equip counselors serving in government orphanages. Through counseling and play therapy, her team restores children's sense of worth and self-image, fulfilling the mission to help families thrive in Christ.

# Stories:

The stories emerging from Mongolia are a testament to the project's impact. For instance, Amarzorig, a father of four daughters, shared how nightly readings from "The Right Choices Bible" have deepened his family's faith and opened meaningful conversations about their relationship with God. Similarly, the Bible's bilingual design has helped children like his daughters improve their English while engaging with scripture.

Amarzorig shares how, "One time, when asking the reflection question, 'How do you view your relationship with the Heavenly Father?', my 6-year-old daughter said, 'I can't see or hear God.' My older daughter responded, 'I feel the same, so I don't really know.' I explained to my daughters that even though we don't see or hear God directly, He speaks to us in our hearts, and we learn how to do what's right by reading His Word. Since then, my daughters ask me every night to read and talk about stories of Jesus. I believe they are growing to love God's Word. For that, I am deeply grateful to all of you."

Through these collaborative efforts, our vision of redeeming families worldwide comes to life. Sami and Hongoroo's partnership exemplifies how teamwork across borders can magnify the reach and impact of the gospel.
